HIGH QUALITY GICLEE CANVAS ART CARE INSTRUCTIONS

The Giclee Art was printed with a digital printer. The ink and the canvas should last for several decades without degradation in a relatively controlled environment. Repeated exposure to extreme and/or sudden changes in humidity or temperature can have an adverse effect on the longevity of your artwork surface and substrate materials.

It is recommended **NOT** to place it in direct sunlight, although, an ultraviolet coating is most cases applied to protect the artwork from harsh sunlight.

SPECIAL ARTWORK CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

**DO NOT RUB OR USE ABRASIVE PRODUCTS TO CLEAN THE ARTWORK.
IF THE CLEANING PRODUCT PENETRATES THE COATING, IT WILL DAMAGE THE PRINT**

A feather duster can be used to remove light dust from the art and the frame. It is acceptable to gently wipe the printed surface with a dry light-colored soft cloth. The light color of the cloth allows you to observe the level of cleaning that you are attempting to accomplish. You can visually measure the cleaning process. If the cloth soils, use several cloths so dirt is not put back onto the artwork.

IF **ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY** the cloth can be dampened with water. Avoid wiping as much as possible, dabbing or blotting is preferred. In extreme cases a small amount of soap and water may be used. In all cases do not press hard on the artwork.

***** DO NOT USE SOLVENTS *****

If necessary, a sample art swatch can be provided for testing prior to cleaning. Additional samples are available upon request.
